

# **How To Update The Chrome Browser On Android**

First you will need to create a Gmail account so you can log in to the Google Play Store.

Once in the Google Play store you will be able to update the Chrome Browser.


The following guide will show you how to do both of these tasks.

## SIGN UP FOR A NEW GMAIL ACCOUNT

The easiest way to do this is by using a Desktop PC. Once you have your new Gmail account you can log into all of your Android phones with the one account.

1.) Go to <http://www.gmail.com>


You'll see the following screen. Click "Create Account":

2.) Fill out the “First Name”, “Last name”, “Username” and “Password” fields.

You’ll want to remember the Username and Password fields because you will use these to sign into your Android phones.

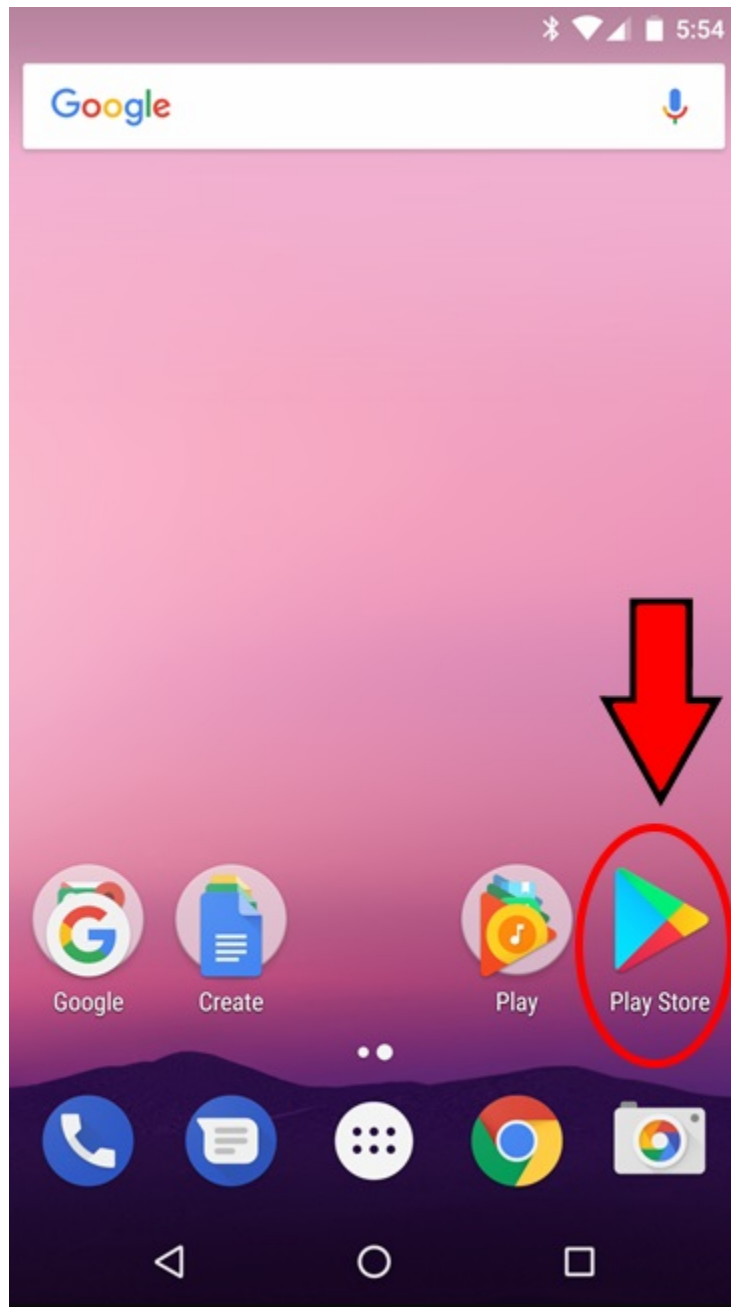

**PLEASE BE AWARE:** Each manufacturer can customize the Android software so your screens may not look exactly the same as below.

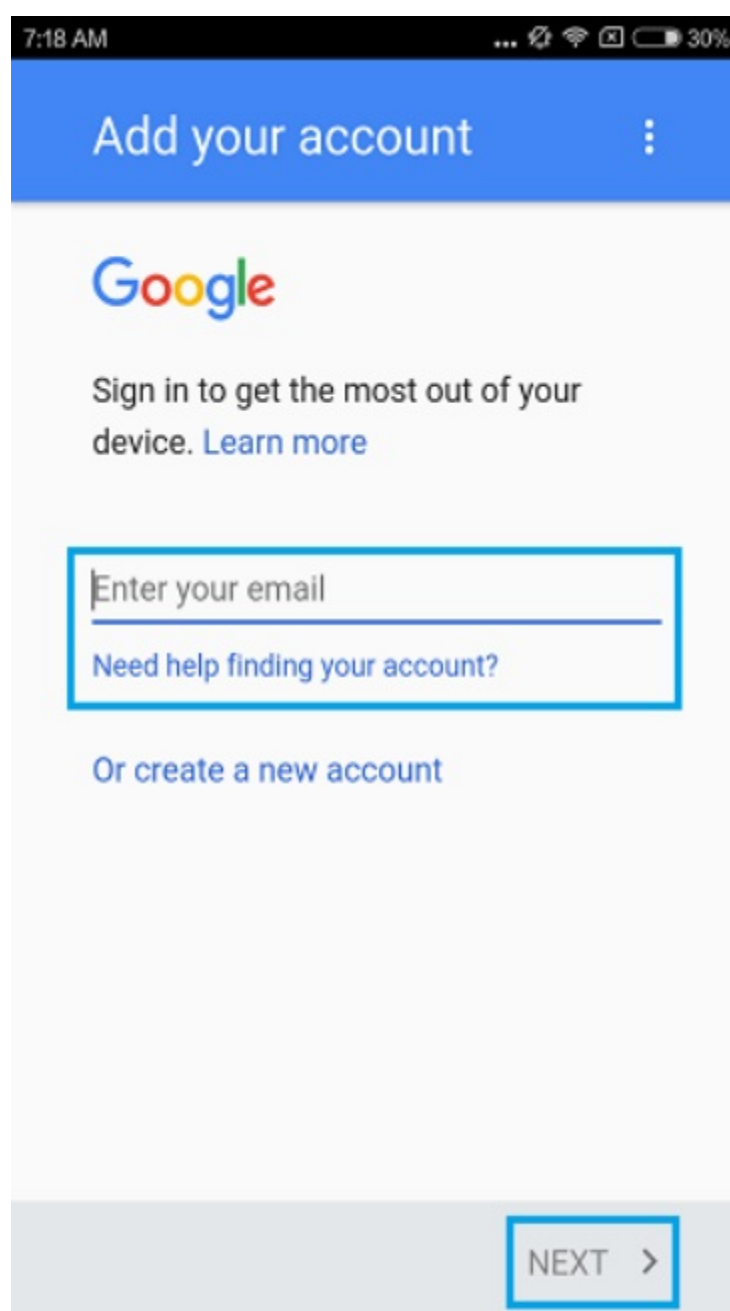
1.) Open the “Play Store”. This should be found on the home screen.




2.) You should be greeted with a screen that looks similar to this one. Use the full email address to sign into the Gmail account you created.

Example: [MyName@gmail.com](mailto:MyName@gmail.com)

Press the “Next” button when you’ve filled out your email address.

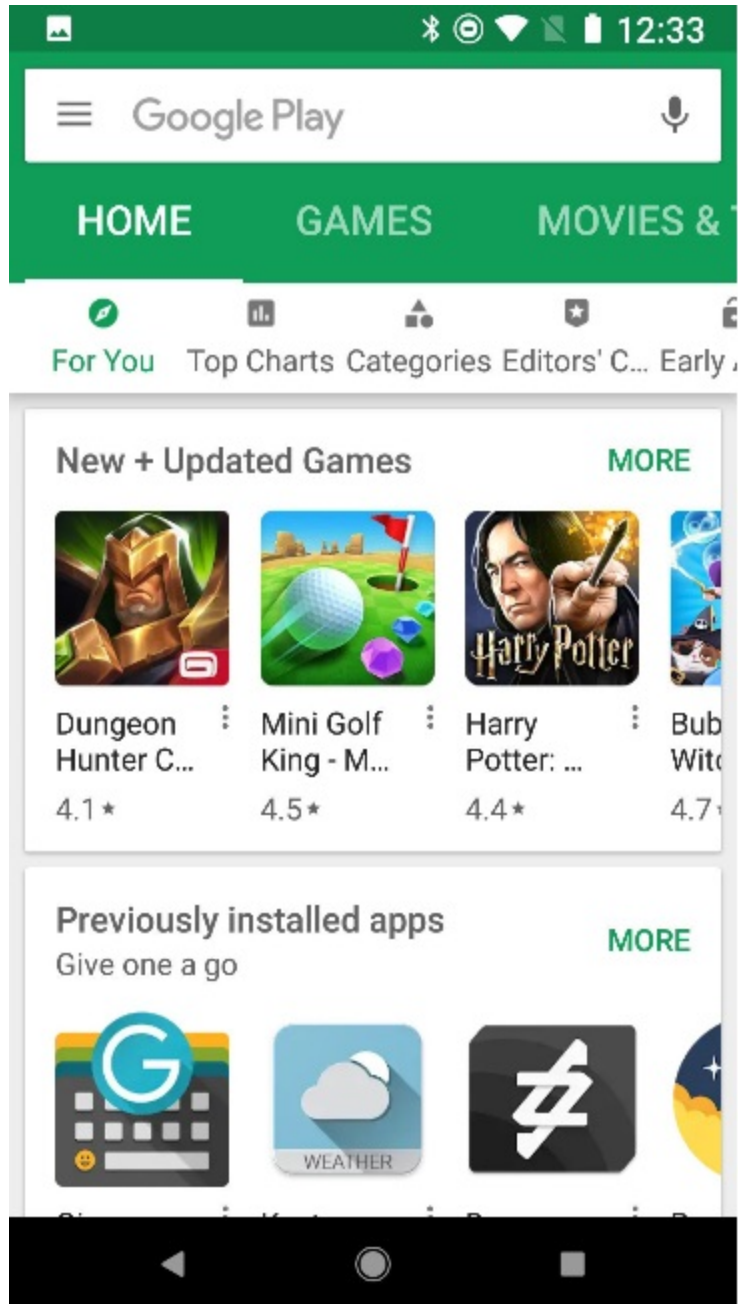

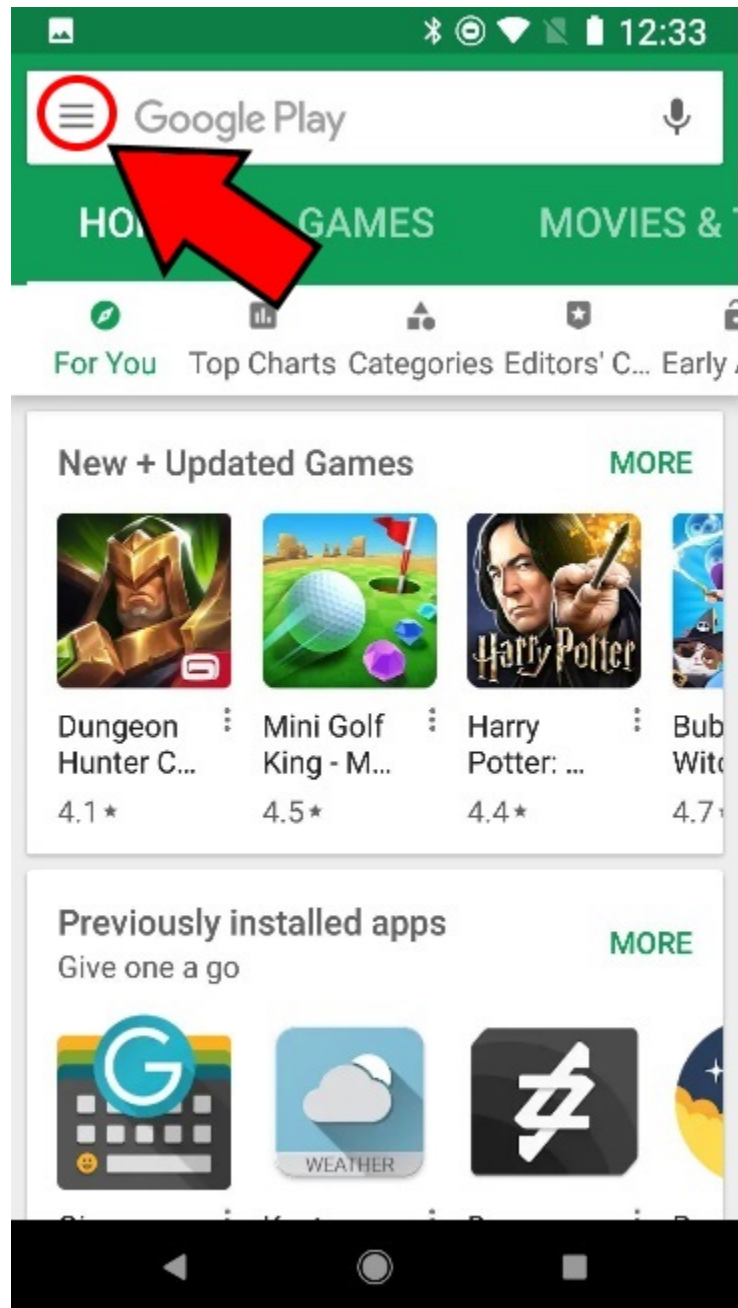

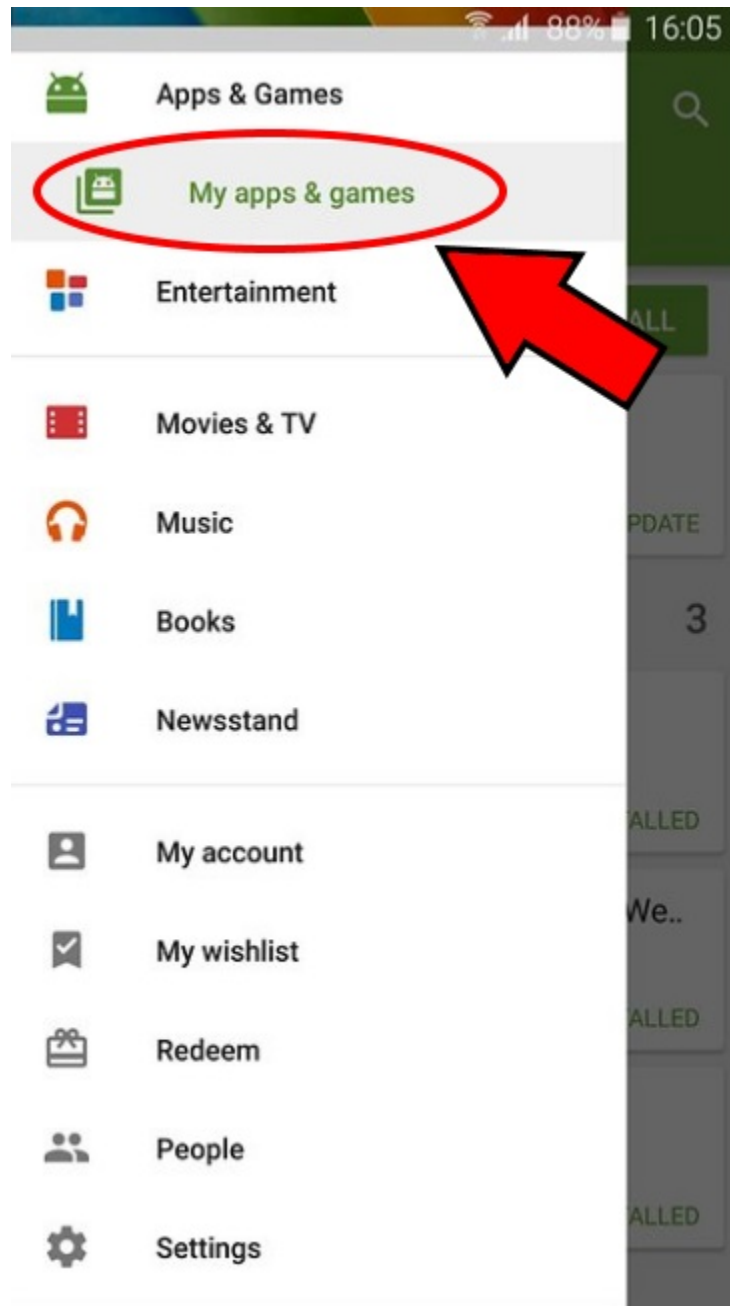
4.) You should arrive at a screen that looks similar to this one.



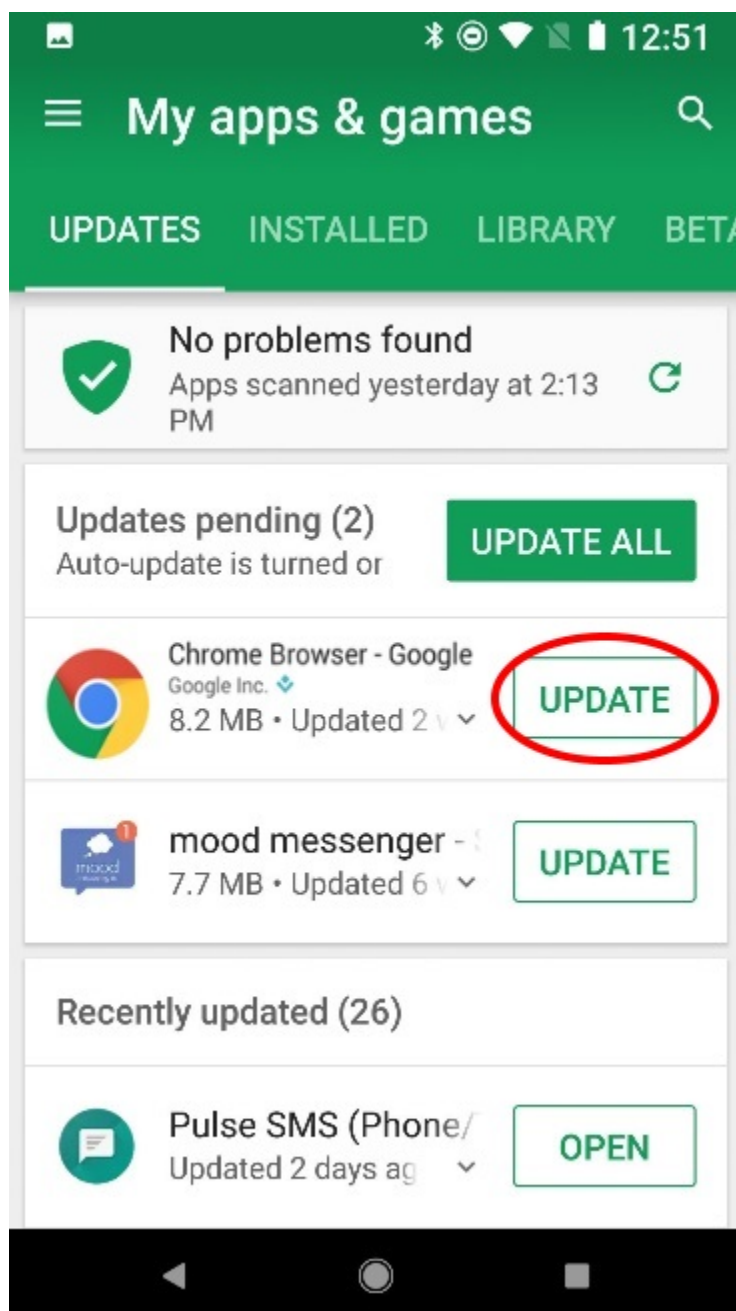
5.) Touch the three horizontal lines at the top left of the screen to bring up the Play Store menu.



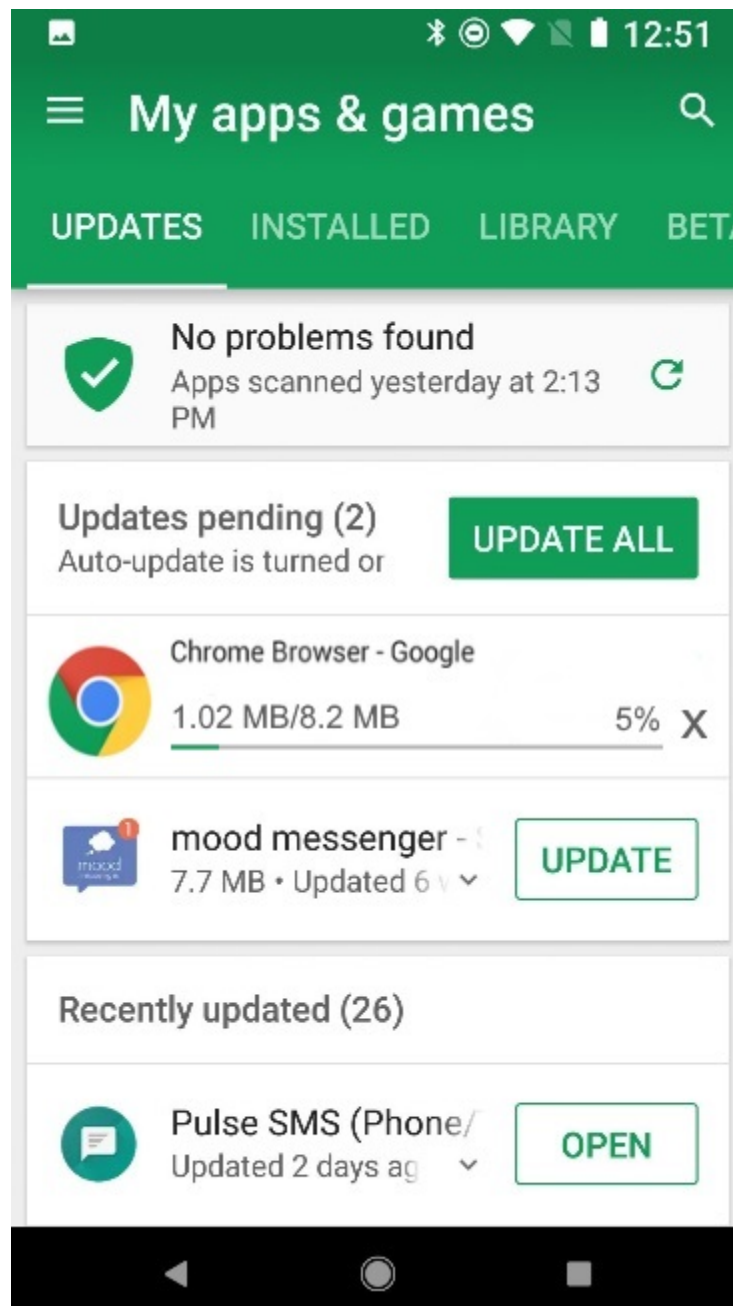
6.) You should see a menu similar to this one. Select “My Apps & Games”.



7.) From this screen you can update the Chrome Browser by touching the “Update” button. You also have the option of updating ALL of your apps. But that is not required.



8.) The download of the Chrome Browser will now start. Depending on how large the download is this may take a few minutes.



9.) Once the download is complete the listing for the Chrome Browser will move down to the “Recently updated” section and have an “Open” button to the right. You can now open the Chrome Browser by pressing the “Open” button.
